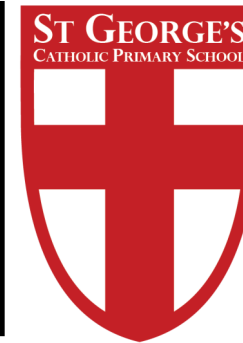

Maths

Understand position through words alone. Talk about and explore 2D and 3D shapes. Experiment with their own symbols and marks as well as numerals. Solve real world mathematical problems with numbers up to 5. Compare quantities using language: 'more than', 'fewer than'.

Have a deep understanding of number to 10. Subitise up to 5. Automatically recall number bonds up to 5 and some number bonds to 10, including double facts. Verbally count beyond 20. Compare quantities up to 10 in different contexts. Explore and represent patterns within numbers up to 10, including evens and odds, double facts and equal quantities.
