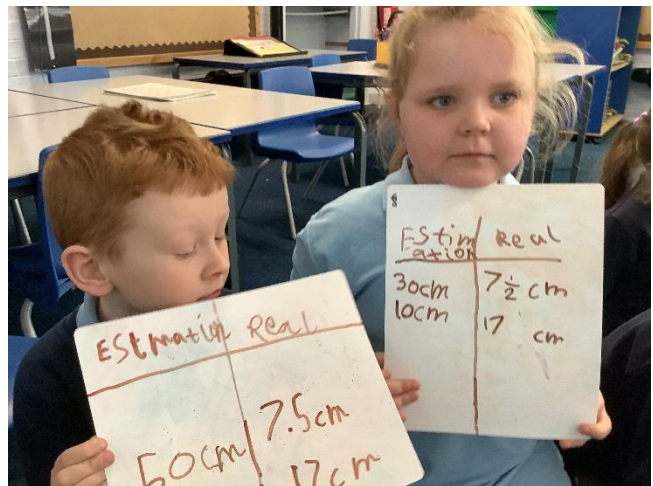


# Year 1/2 Blog

What a fantastic week we have had! In English, our work on Whatever Next is coming to a close, and is ending with us completing a retell of the story itself; we have been writing step sentences to help us to prepare.
