#### **Macmillan Coffee Morning**

Thank you so much to everyone who donated or who attended our recent coffee morning to raise much-needed funds for Macmillan. The morning was a great success and we raised £225 in total which is just brilliant.

#### **New Behaviour for Learning Policy**

#### **New First Aid Procedures**

With regards to the First Aid procedures, we have identified some small changes in how we share this information with parents/carers in future.

From now on, if your child has a minor accident in school, they will be examined and supported by a qualified first aider. First aid will be administered where necessary and this will be recorded in the school's First Aid Book. This information will be shared with the class teacher who will share this information with you at the end of the school day.

If your child has a minor bump to their head, they will be examined and supported by a qualified First Aider. First Aid treatment will be administered and recorded. A 'Head Injury' letter will be completed and shared with the class teacher. This will be passed to the adult collecting your child at the end of the school day. The letter contains advice around 'bump to the head' symptoms to look out for during the rest of the day/night.

If school have any concerns at all about any injury, we will always contact parents/carers or contact emergency services, if necessary.

#### Harvest and Lemington Food Bank Collection

Next week, we will be celebrating our Harvest Liturgy in school where we will be thinking about the needs of our global family and those closer to home. As part of the liturgy, we will be asking children to bring any spare items of food or toiletries into school which could be donated to Lemington Food Bank. We will also be linking our Harvest work to 'Enterprise Week' and any items made by the children will be put on display and then purchased by parents/carers if they are able or choose to. Any funds raised by school from Enterprise Week will be donated to CAFOD.

#### Wraparound Care - After School Club

Due to small numbers of children accessing our After School Club and lack of parents/carers needing this type of provision, we are considering reducing the finish time of our After School Club to 5.30pm. We obviously want to continue to support our families as much as we can but we are also conscious of our school budget and using our school resources efficiently. Breakfast club wraparound care will continue as normal from 7.45.

#### Access to Free Breakfast Food for All Children

From Monday 7 November, through Greggs Foundation, St George's will be offering a **free breakfast** to all children from Nursery through to Year 6. This will include juice, cereal bars, fruit, pastries and bread and will be offered to all children on arrival into school. Thank you so much to Mrs Watson for organising this. **Please note, the school gates will open as normal at 8.45am.**
