Dear Parents/Carers,

Welcome to the new academic year of 2022 - 2023.

Bank Holiday – Monday 19th September

As you know, Monday 19th September has been declared a Bank Holiday as a mark of respect for the State Funeral of HM Queen Elizabeth II. St George's will be closed on the Monday and will re-open as usual on Tuesday 20th September.

St George's and St Cuthbert's - Strengthening Schools' Partnership

I am delighted to have been given the opportunity to lead two schools across our Trust. This opportunity allows for new ways of working in partnership and the sharing of skills, expertise and workforce. As such, staff from both schools will be visiting each other's sites on a regular basis supporting with curriculum developments, teaching and learning and a whole host of other school-based initiatives. This is a really exciting time for both schools to further improve and develop for the good of all of the children.

Changing from Packed Lunches to School Meals and Vice Versa

The food and supplies needed to make school meals is ordered on a monthly basis. To help us ensure we are spending our school meals' budget effectively and not wasting food already ordered and paid for, could parents/carers please give school the required **one week notice** either via email, a letter into school or phone call before you opt for a change. Thank you.

Wraparound Care – Breakfast Club and After School Club

We are currently offering full wraparound provision from 7.45am until 6pm. Breakfast Club and After School Club Wraparound Provision is led by our fully-qualified school staff. The provision is run on a not-for-profit basis and prices are kept as low as possible to help support parents and carers who need this type of provision.

The provision is open to children from Reception to Year 6.

Breakfast Club runs from 7.45am until the beginning of the school day and costs £2.00 per child per day. Any child in receipt of a Free School Meal can access the Breakfast Club for free. Parents and carers need to complete a Registration Form to enable their child to access Breakfast Club. Once this form is completed, children can access this provision as and when parents and carers need it. There is no need to pre-book.

After School Club runs from 3.15pm until 6pm and costs £5.00 from 3.15pm until 4.30pm and £8.00 from 3.15pm until 6.00pm. Parents and carers need to complete a Booking Form. All After School Sessions will need to be booked and paid for in advance and no later than 9.00am on the day the provision is needed.
