We also manage our After School provision between us and run extra-curricular clubs and I am keen not to add further to this. I am sorry that my response to this suggestion is not more useful to the parent who shared it.
Open up both gates at school opening and closing times.	We already completed a survey on this and only one parent/carers wanted this change to happen. All other responses we received agreed with the change of gates in favour of the safety of the children.
Speak to parents and carers more about changes to school and not just through messaging because technology is not always reliable.	Have made massive improvements during the last few years and we do always try to communicate any changes in a timely and effective manner. We will try and continue to improve this further.
More school trips, more activities for the children, better playground facilities as the current ones are dangerous.	<p>We have increased school trips and visitors into school over the last few years and this will continue to improve year on year.</p> <p>As for the playground facilities, I can confirm with all our parents and carers that they are absolutely safe. We have just had all of the necessary repairs completed and our safety inspection was carried out last week.</p>
