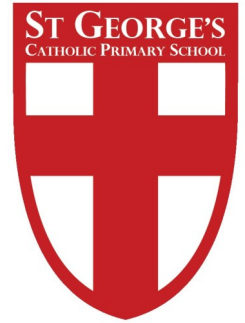




# St George's Early Years

### Phonics

Reception: FFT phonics.

Word and sentence reading and writing. Bending and segmenting. Tricky/Red words and digraph/trigraph sounds.

Nursery: Nursery Rhymes.

General sound discrimination:

Rhythm and Rhyme.

Alliteration. Voice sounds.

Oral blending and segmenting.

### Religious Education

- *Pentecost:* GOOD NEWS - Passing on the Good News of Jesus.
- *Reconciliation:* FRIENDS - Friends of Jesus.
- *Universal Church:* OUR WORLD - God's wonderful world.

### Six Key Areas of Early Mathematics Learning.

Following Mastering Number scheme.

Cardinality and Counting Understanding that the cardinal value of a number refers to the quantity, or 'howmanyness' of things it represents.

Comparison Understanding that comparing numbers involves knowing which numbers are worth more or less than each other.

Composition Understanding that one number can be made up from (composed from) two or more smaller numbers.

Pattern Looking for and finding patterns helps children notice and understand mathematical relationships.

Shape and Space & Measures.
