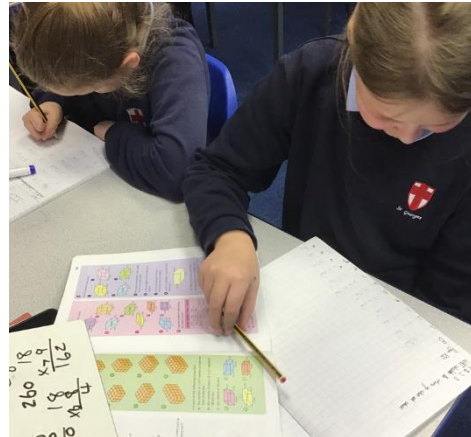


Year 5/6 Week ending: 10/2/23

They found mixing the sugar with the yeast solution was most successful as it uses the sugar for energy to grow.

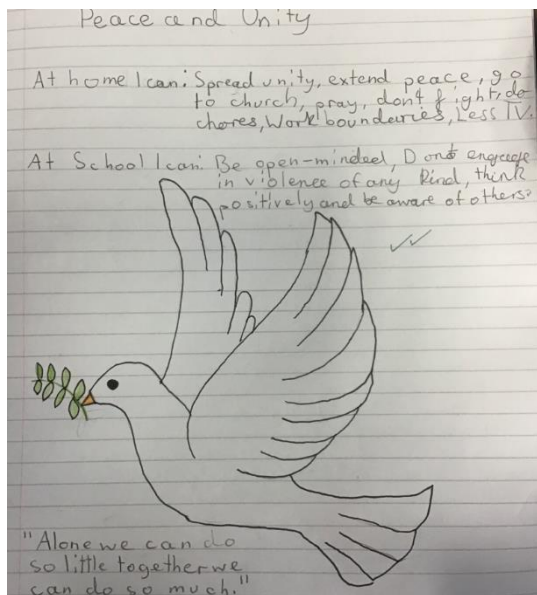
What an impressive week of writing! Producing high-quality build ups including key events and our dilemma.

Smeagol has been a great character to spark our imaginations.



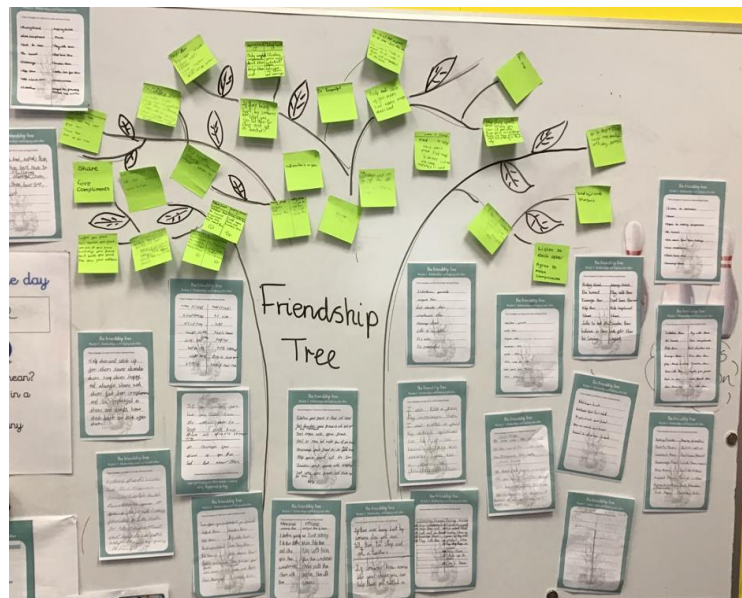
Our 'Safeguarding Buddies' led an informative assembly to explain to the school all things internet safety.
