# Important Laws



- ♥ It is illegal to steal
- ♥ It is illegal to assault/ hurt others
- ♥ It is illegal to drive too fast or when someone has been drinking too much alcohol
- ♥ It is illegal to discriminate against someone based on the colour of their skin, their religion and their sexuality

1.	<u>Take Care of Yourself</u>
Never	1. Do anything silly or dangerous where you might be hurt. Leave school without permission. Talk to strangers in school unless they have a school badge.
Always	1. Tell someone if you are unhappy, being picked on or bullied.
2.	<u>Take Care of Others</u>
Never	1. Do anything to hurt others (such as hitting/name calling). Distract others from working. Be cheeky or rude to adults.
Always	1. Be friendly and respectful to visitors, newcomers and other children. 2. Play fairly.
3.	<u>Take Care of your School</u>
Never	1. Steal or deliberately damage school equipment. Drop litter or deface the school building. Give the school a bad name.
Always	1. Be proud of your school.
