1.	<u>Take Care of Yourself</u>

2.	<u>Take Care of Others</u>
Never	 Do anything to hurt others (such as hitting/name calling). Distract others from working. Be cheeky or rude to adults.
Always	 Be friendly and respectful to visitors, newcomers and other children. Play fairly.
3.	Take Care of your School
Never	 Steal or deliberately damage school equipment. Drop litter or deface the school building. Give the school a bad name.
Always	1. Be proud of your school.
