

Year 5/6 Autumn 1

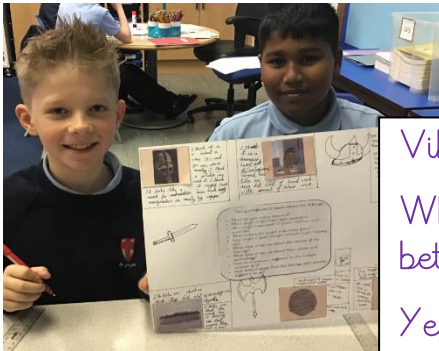
This half term, our writing has been based around the music video Titanium.

Evolution and Inheritance was a new topic for Year 5/6.

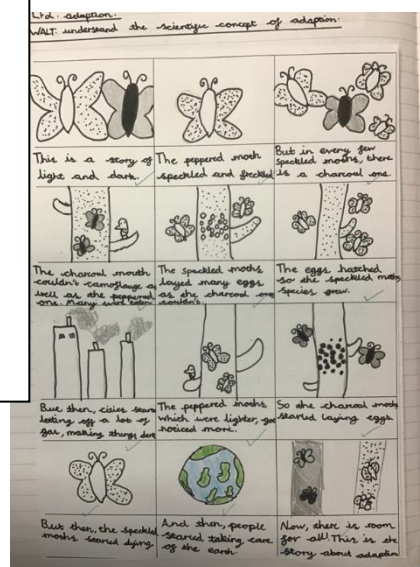
They looked at the work of Charles Darwin and 'The Theory of Evolution'.
