

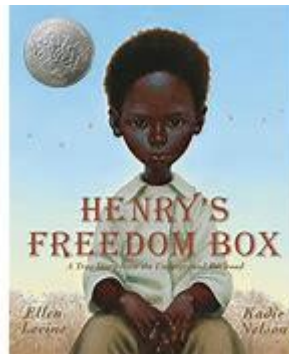
Year 5/6 Spring 25
