This week started with some hands-on re-capping of angles.

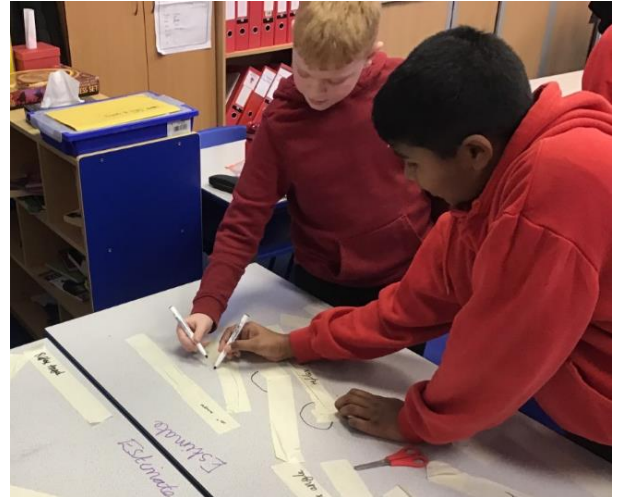
Year 5/6 then moved on to measuring angles with a protractor and finding missing angles using our knowledge of shape.
