Use words and phrases such as old, new, a long time ago, before and after with accuracy – (Polar Explorers, Grace Darling, Seaside now and then)

Look at books to find out about the past: Books to match Grace Darling and Seaside now and in the past ('Gracie the Lighthouse Cat', 'The Sea Saw')

Retell a familiar story set in the past in Chronological order (Grace Darling)

Look at different versions of the same event in history and identify differences. Seaside now and then – the experience of a rich family compared with the experiences of a poor family.

Recognise that a story may have happened a long time ago- (Grace Darling)

Recount personal history and events or changes that have happened – the Wright Brothers and air travel.
