We have started to create maths notebooks – filling them with rules and top tips!

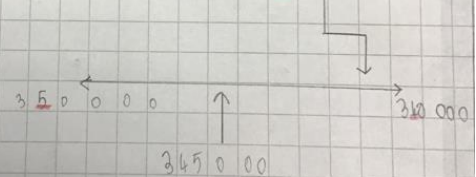
Compare and order
