You said	So we
You said Give children more homework.  Ongoing and historic concerns around 'bullying' which many parents believe has improved since Autumn 2022. However, some parents feel this is still an issue at St George's.	So we  Have reviewed all our homework expectations and polices again this term and will share this information as soon as possible.  Have undertaken lots of work in school in this area which includes:  - A completely revised and renewed whole school Personal, Health, Social and Emotional curriculum  - New Behaviour for Learning Policy  - New Anti-bullying Policy  - New Child on Child Abuse Policy  - Ongoing staff training on managing and dealing with low level disruption and more challenging behaviour, including incidences of perceived 'bullying'
	incidences of perceived 'bullying'  - Assemblies, workshops, lessons all aimed at upskilling children in identifying what bullying is and dealing with 'bullying' which includes the NSPCC 'Speak out! Stay Safe!' programme  - Promoted NSPCC Childline services
	In light of these ongoing concerns, we will be sending out a further survey to our families to complete which focuses solely on this issue.
	This will enable parents and carers to provide more detailed feedback and provide an opportunity to visit school and meet with your child's class teacher and the headteacher to discuss your concerns directly and hopefully help resolve this issue for you and your child.
