

Year 3 & 4 Spring Term

English: In English this half term our writing will be linked to history. We will be looking at Greek myths, how they originated and what their purpose was. Specifically, we will be looking at the 12 labours of Hercules finding out who Hercules was, what kind of character he was and why he had to complete 12 arduous labours.

PE will be on Monday and Friday's this half term.

APEX will be keeping our children very active with some fun sessions.

Friday will be swimming and we are all very excited!

PSHE we will be looking at how we value ourselves, how we relate to others and to the wider world.

Weekly spellings will be sent home to be practised for our Friday test. Please practise rock star times tables and investigate Super mover times tables on BBC Bitesize.

Home readers will be changed each Friday. Please ensure that these are brought into school each Friday morning.

Fractions and decimals are our focus this half term. We will use concrete materials to examine what a unit fraction is and what a non-unit fraction is. We will investigate fractions of quantities and how we make a whole.

Using number lines, we will be counting forwards and backwards using fractions and then examine what equivalent fractions are.

Decimal equivalents will also be investigated.

Problem solving using our knowledge will extend our learning.

History this half term investigates the Ancient Greeks. What was their society all about, how do we know so much about them – Have they influenced life today?
