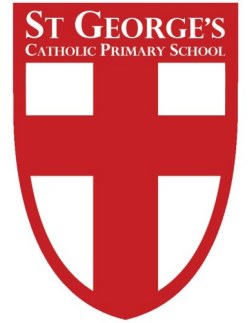




# St George's Early Years
